

SANTA TERESA WOMEN'S GOLF CLUB  
General Meeting September 6, 2018

Captain Barbara Hiura called the meeting to order at 1:10. She announced that the Captain's Trophy winner for July was Ingrit Sander with 93-26-67. Becke Reese won low gross with a score of 78. August Captain's Trophy winner was Naomi Nakano with 104-40-64. Becke Reese won low gross with a score of 80. Patti Donovan broke 100 for the first time on June 28 and was awarded a Break-100 award. Micki Lico broke 90 for the first time on June 21 and again on June 28 and was awarded a Break-90 award.

Connie Smith, who has been recovering and rehabbing for almost a year, was present for the general meeting for the first time in a long while and says that she will try to start playing golf again next week.

SECRETARY: Sue Treleaven moved to waive the reading of the last General Meeting minutes of June 7, 2018. Megan Lovelace seconded it and the motion was carried.

TREASURER: Deanna Griffin presented the treasurer's report as of September 6, 2018 showing a checkbook balance of \$14,705.10. The previous checkbook balance as of June 7, 2018 was \$7,721.00. Helen Meyer moved that the treasurer's report be approved. Barbara Reghitto seconded it and the motion was carried.

HANDICAP: Marie LeBlanc was absent.

TOURNAMENT: Tournament and Pairings Chairs had no report.

MAJOR TOURNAMENTS: Mona Nakamura stated that 38 members are now signed up for the Club Championship on October 11 and 18. Deadline for signing up is September 15.

P.W.G.A./N.C.G.A. REP: Dora Moutafian noted the upcoming play days and will be emailing monthly reminders to the members prior to each event. She noted that the Helen Langfeld Tournament will be held on October 2 and 3.

GOLF GENIUS UPDATE: Dora gave extensive information on the new Golf Genius website which will replace eclubhouse in 2019. She will be in charge of this as we get used to using this new website. She explained how each member must sign onto the website with their own individual password. All will be secure and protected. The website will show weekly Tee Sheets, results, player information page, calendar of events, social, newsletter, membership information and email blasts. Most importantly, it will allow for tee time signups three weeks in advance. Players can sign up for a specific tee time and play with whom they wish when space is available as everything is on a first come first served basis. One advantage is that everyone will have equal access since you can do it from home on your computer or smart-phone and there is no chance of duplicate sign ups as you can only sign up for yourself. The pro-shop is on board

and has the capability of handling this format.

An email will be sent to each member when the sign up for a play date is open. The member may log onto the website at that time or after that to sign up. The sign up will remain available on the website until closing date. To cancel she must sign on and remove her name from the play date. If the tee times are full she will be put on a wait list. As players cancel, the first on the wait list will fill that space. Players will still be able to sign up 3 weeks in advance as always. The opening time when members are able to sign up will be on Thursday evening at 7:00 P.M. and the website will remain open until the following Tuesday at 7:00 P.M. before the following Thursday play day. It was decided that we would begin website sign ups on October 4 for the play day on October 25.

NEWSLETTER EDITOR: Megan Lovelace asked that all articles be sent to her by September 13. She will include the information regarding Golf Genius.

MEMBER AT LARGE: Renee Perry presented the 2019 Board of Directors. Gina Gordon moved that the roster be accepted, Megan Lovelace seconded it and the motion was carried.

STARTERS AND SCORERS: Phyllis Fujii said that it was time to sign up for starter and scorer duty for next year. She reminded us that board members need not sign up for duty unless they choose to do so.

Super Guest Day: Pat Baldovi said that there were now 124 players signed up for Super Guest Day. Cutoff date for sign ups is September 11. Raffle tickets are being sold in advance and will go to a non-profit yet to be named. Donations for the raffle are still being gratefully accepted.

She also asked that someone from Santa Teresa volunteer to be on the board for the Santa Clara County Women's Golf. She also wanted to make sure that the Club Champion takes part in the County Championship.
